




If your child has a need that is not currently being met by the school please contact us.



Full consultation through EHCP review process.






If you wish to discuss your child's provision you can request a meeting.


We may make a mistake or disagree about something. Discussions allows these issues to be explored.

Students fully involved in shaping their provision.










Whenever a new pupil joins the school, irrespective of identified need, we will meet with them and their parents and discuss their introduction to school life.






