Role:

To work as a Jewish Studies teacher, and as part of a highly dedicated, experienced, successful and professional team creating learning opportunities and a vibrant Jewish atmosphere throughout school for all students.

Main Duties:

- 1. Organise and manage an appropriate learning environment in the classroom
- 2. Plan challenging teaching and learning objectives
- 3. Monitor and evaluate student responses to learning activities through a range of assessment and monitoring strategies against pre-determined learning objectives
- 4. Provide objective and accurate feedback and reports to colleagues, parents and students
- 5. Record progress and achievement in lessons/activities systematically and provide evidence of the range and level of progress and attainment
- 6. Establish a clear framework for discipline in line with established policy, anticipate and manage behaviour constructively, promoting independence, creativity and resilience
- 7. Support the role of parents in students' learning and contribute to/lead meetings with parents to provide constructive feedback on student progress/achievement etc
- 8. Use detailed knowledge and specialist skills to support and progress students' learning
- 9. Establish productive working relationships with students, acting as a role model and setting high expectations

- 10. Promote the inclusion and acceptance of all students within the classroom
- 11. Support students consistently whilst recognising and responding to their individual needs
- 12. Encourage students to interact and work co-operatively with others and engage all students in activities
- 13. Deliver learning activities to students, adjusting activities according to student responses/needs
- 14. Use ICT effectively to support learning activities and develop students' competence and independence in its use
- 15. Select and prepare resources necessary to deliver learning activities, taking account of students' interests and language and cultural backgrounds
- 16. Support for the School and its ethos
- 17. Comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, equal opportunities, health, safety and security, confidentiality and data protection, reporting concerns to an appropriate person
- 18. Be aware of and support difference and ensure all students have equal access to opportunities to learn and develop
- 19. Contribute to the overall ethos/work/aims of the school
- 20. Share resources with the Kodesh department and cooperate in team efforts to develop Kodesh at both schools LJFS and Brodetsky Jewish Primary School on the campus
- 21. Establish constructive relationships and communicate with other agencies/professionals, in liaison with your subject leader, to support achievement and progress of students
- 22. Take personal responsibility to promote and safeguard the welfare of children and young persons; those for whom there is direct responsibility or come into contact with
