If the information is not confirmed by the named person/people then the child will not be considered a priority application for the places reserved for Jewish pupils. However, they will still be considered using other oversubscription criteria.

Jewish pupils will be ranked based on the scores achieved on this form and places will be allocated accordingly. Only those pupils who achieve a score of 4 or more will be considered as a Jewish pupil.
